### **Requirements For Resuming CCTC Hikes on July 1, 2020**

1. Club Responsibilities:
  - a. Coincident with publication of CCTC's Third Quarter 2020 (July-August-September) Hiking Schedule, publish an Announcement to all Club members about the hiking procedures affected by COVID-19 that will be in place when Club hikes resume. The same Announcement will be posted on the Club's Website and on the Club's Facebook page.
  - b. Keep track of and announce any COVID-19 restriction changes as identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and State and County governments.
2. Individual Responsibilities:
  - a. Stay home when not feeling well.
  - b. Follow Hike Leader directions.
  - c. All hikers must have a facial mask and wear it at the Hike Leader's direction and whenever appropriate.
  - d. Maintain a distance of at least six feet between individuals during the circle-up and the hike.
  - e. Whenever any hiker coughs or sneezes, they must turn to the side and cover their mouth and nose to avoid coughing or sneezing in anyone's direction.
3. Limits on Number of Hikers per Hike:
  - a. No limit on the total number of hikers per hike, except as limited by current COVID-19 restrictions.
  - b. If more hikers show up for a hike than COVID-19 restrictions allow for a single group, the group will be split into however many groups are necessary to remain in compliance with COVID-19 group size and distancing restrictions.
4. Hike Leader Responsibilities:
  - a. Sign-in every hiker.
  - b. Confirm that all hikers have a facial mask. If any hikers do not have masks, inform them that they must use some other facial covering, such as a bandana or other article of clothing to cover their mouth and nose when required to do so by the Hike Leader.
  - c. Request hikers to put masks on when in close proximity to other people.
  - d. Hike Leaders must not schedule any hike that requires carpooling or shuttles.
  - e. Remind everyone of COVID-19 social distancing requirements among CCTC hikers as well as anyone else who is closely encountered during a hike's activity.
